## BUMPY WASHCLOTH

---



CH = Chain  
SL ST = Slip Stitch  
SC = Single Crochet  
DC = Double Crochet  
TR = Treble or Triple crochet  
SK = Skip Stitch

### **SUGGESTED YARNS**

100% WORSTED WEIGHT  
COTTON YARN

5.0 (H) HOOK

SCISSORS  
TAPESTRY NEEDLE

*approximate size:*

**Row 1:** Chain 26 or to desired width. Keep multiples of 2.  
Chain one and turn.

**Row 2 (Foundation):** SC in next stitch (not counting the turn stitch) SC in each stitch (26) Chain one and turn.

**Row 3 (Bump Row):** \*SC in next stitch. TR in next stitch.  
Repeat \* until end (26) chain one and turn.

**Row 4:** Repeat row 2 & 3 until you get your desired length.

**Finishing Row:** Repeat Row 2 (foundation row)

**Frame (Optional):** Be creative and choose your favorite stitch and stitch around the washcloth to give a decorative look. Make sure you add extra stitches to the corners.

### **Frame Suggestions:**

1. **Charlotte Stitch:** \*SC in next stitch. 2DC in same SC. SK2 and repeat \*. Do this around the washcloth. On corners add to extra DC in same space as the stitch to make a corner. SL ST into first stitch to finish off. Weave off ends.
2. **Basic DC:** \*DC into each stitch all the way around. Work 4 DC into Corners to make rounded corners. SL ST to finish off. Weave off ends.

*Note: You can adjust this pattern to make multiple sizes. Just add a longer foundation and more rows. Make sure you work in multiples of 2.*
